Camp Counselor Job Responsibilities:

- Preps supplies for assigned activities.
- Keeps work areas clean and safe. Ensures the cleanliness of the overall site.
- Supervises campers and ensures their safety, development, growth, skill achievement, and general well-being.
- Knows, enforces, and follows all safety guidelines associated with the camp program, including knowing the whereabouts of youth participants at all times.
- Assists in maintaining accurate program records, including incident reports and daily attendance.
- Knows and understands all emergency procedures associated with the camp program.
- Mediates any campers' disputes.
- Follows required dress code including appropriate footwear.
